

"TRAMP"

T TIME	Check the order for when it would be given and when was the last time it was given.	
R ROUTE	Check the order if it's through oral, IV, SQ, IM, or etc.	
A AMOUNT (DOSE)	Check the medication sheet and the doctor's order before medicating. Be aware of the difference of an adult and a pediatric dose.	
M MEDICATION	Check and verify if it's the right name and form. Beware of look-alike and sound-alike medication names.	
P PATIENT	Ask the name of the client and check his ID band before administering. Even if you know that patient's name, you still need to ask just to verify.



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
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
