WHAT THE BILL WILL DO




Passport Seizure
All work the Home Secretary will seize passports of those leaving the UK if a person is suspected of terrorism-related activity.




Temporary Exclusion
To give the Home Secretary power to issue Temporary Exclusion Orders (TEOs) preventing British nationals from returning to the UK if a person is suspected of terrorism-related activity.




Expanding Prevent
Extend Prevent to include the Maritime Law, Public Order, from university campuses to police officers to City and primary school teachers – will legally have a duty to report concerns.




Authority to Carry
Extend the Home Secretary's authority to carry out checks that allow the right to carry passengers (to and from the UK) providing they are passengers on board.




TPIMs
Expand the use of TPIMs (Temporary Prohibited Imports) to include the Home Secretary's power to restrict the movement of persons suspected of terrorism-related activity within the UK.



Data Retention
Requires commercial service providers to retain communications data that will help identify and prevent terrorism-related activity.



Ransom
Makes it illegal to insure or provide cover to any ransom for terrorist groups.



Privacy and Civil Liberties Board
Establishes a Privacy and Civil Liberties Board to provide oversight to intelligence and counter-terrorism legislation.

WHO GETS THE POWER?

Home Secretary

The bill gives the Secretary of State (currently Theresa May, in charge of the Home Office since 12 December 2015) the power to issue TEOs. The Home Secretary will have the power to issue TEOs to British nationals who will be leaving the UK. 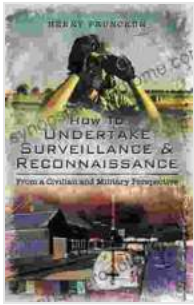

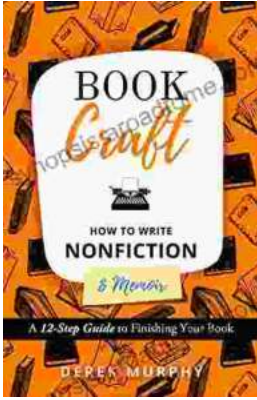
